Information for the Talented Football Program 2019

The Crestwood High School Talented Football Program is an initiative to support the development of students with exceptional football capabilities. The partnership between Crestwood High School and Sydney FC aims to develop athletes as students and responsible members of our school community. It is an expectation that successful applicants to this program will have a demonstrated commitment to learning and respect of school values. Therefore, applicants are required to submit the last two (most recent) school reports. A panel will review applications and assess suitability of applicants for enrolment at Crestwood High School.

Once suitability has been determined, athletes will be invited to trial for the program.

Parents will be notified in writing regarding the outcome of their child's application.

Successful applicants are required to represent the school in any NSW CHSSA carnival, game or competition for which he/she is selected. It is compulsory that Talented Football Program students compete to the best of their ability at the school Athletics, Cross Country and Swimming carnivals and represent the school at Zone, Regional and State level if selected.

Students may be interviewed and/or photographed by the media throughout the year. Crestwood High School is proud of the achievements of their students and these may be celebrated in print and/or electronic forms of publication.

Students who are selected into the Talented Football Program are required to pay an annual fee of \$650. This covers the costs of coaching, equipment, excursions, entry into competitions, and a training and playing uniform. The training strip must be worn to all training sessions. Fees are not a voluntary contribution. Full payment in advance is required prior to participation in the program. If you have difficulties paying these fees, part payment options may be negotiated with the Principal.
