Education Perfect is an online learning tool that Crestwood High School has adopted to support learning across all Key Learning Areas.

Education Perfect enables students to access learning resources at home and at school which provides structured lessons suitable for individual learning. These lessons start with introductory slides so students gain a good understanding of the topic before it's taught. Rich images and videos break down difficult concepts and give students a thorough understanding of the topic.

Key features

- All content aligns with the current Australian curriculum, teachers are able to work with Education Perfect subject experts customizing content to match their students' needs.
- Multiple testing modes; improve understanding, recall and higher-order thinking.
- Touch Device Compatible – iOS and Android applications available.
- Teachers receive reports showing which areas of the curriculum students found most difficult, supporting differentiated teaching techniques.
- Enabling a “flipped classroom” – students can come to class familiar with the content, allowing students to spend more time on advanced topics and hands on activities.
- Differentiated learning – every student can be working on a different task according to their strengths and weaknesses.
