GENERAL SCHOOL CONTRIBUTION, TECHNOLOGY AND SUBJECT MATERIAL CONTRIBUTIONS 2021 – YEAR 7

As a public high school, Crestwood relies heavily on school contributions and elective fees. Funds raised through these contributions are used to supplement educational resources, programs in our school and projects that enhance the quality of educational delivery. They also significantly support major projects such as facility and technology upgrades.

The General School Contribution for Year 7 is \$50.00. The Technology Contribution is \$60.00, the Subject Material Contribution is \$135.00, the Sport Levy Fee is \$20.00 and the Textbook/Resource Fee \$50.00. Details of the manner in which funds may be expended are outlined below. The Education Perfect and Mathspace Online Programs are interactive and engaging online learning environments that complement in class learning available to students. These programs are provided externally from the school therefore incur a fee (as per overleaf).

Included on the attached form is provision for families to make a donation to the P & C Association. All funds received by the P & C Association are used to benefit students at the school. The P & C Association has requested that this donation be \$50.00 per family (not per student).
