### YEAR 11 PHYSICS EXCURSION TO LUNA PARK

On **Monday 5<sup>th</sup> December**, Year 11 Physics students will be participating in an excursion to Luna Park, North Sydney, as part of their work on motion, forces and energy. They will be analyzing the rides and activities in terms of g forces, acceleration, and gravitational and kinetic energy transformations, to show practical applications of the material studied in the Physics class.

The cost of the excursion will be **\$60.00** for the park ticket (including unlimited rides during the excursion), study material and bus travel, which is payable to the Student Services Window **no later than Friday 18<sup>th</sup> November 2022**. The permission slip below must be fully completed, signed and returned by this date or students may not be able to attend the activity.

Students will be travelling by bus to Luna Park, in combination with the Year 7 Mathematics Excursion also travelling to Luna Park on the same day and returning by bus to the school after the activity. The bus will be leaving school at **9:00 am**, and students will go from Home Room to the COLA where they will be briefed on the day's activities and presented with the worksheets. It is anticipated that the bus will return to school by 3:00 pm, although unavoidable traffic delays may not make this possible.

Students are expected to be equipped with a pen and paper, and to be in **full school uniform** (female students may wear smart casual appropriate pants, students not in appropriate uniform may be excluded from attending the excursion, and a refund may not be possible). Students **MUST** wear closed in shoes. A student workbook will be issued before our departure. Facilities are available for purchasing food, however prices are quite high, and it is recommended that students bring their own morning tea and lunch. Note that no glass or metal containers are allowed on the site.

Luna Park Sydney will be open to the general public at the time of the excursion. Other schools or groups may be present during the excursion. Several rides have height restrictions, generally either 130cm or 106 cm. Most rides are **NOT** recommended for persons who have had recent surgery or illness; have plaster casts or broken bones; back, neck or bone injuries; high blood pressure; cardiovascular problems or nervous disorders.
