A feature of the public education system in NSW is the opportunity to provide time in class for education in ethics, faith and morality from a religious perspective at the choice of parents.

The SRE option available at Crestwood High School is a Protestant SRE (provided by the Anglican Diocese of Sydney). Students not attending SRE are given supervised alternative meaningful activities.

Students continue in the same arrangement each year, unless a parent/caregiver has requested a change in writing. At any time, you have the right to change your SRE nomination or to withdraw your child from the nominated lessons. A note to the Deputy Principal will affect this change.
