YEAR 7 PEER SUPPORT CAMP - FINAL INFORMATION

Dear Parents/Caregivers,

This information concerns the final details of your child's Year 7 Camp to The Tops Conference Centre, Stanwell Tops.

<u>Departure</u>: You are required to have your child at school on Monday 4th March by 8.30am at the Bus Bay <u>Return</u>: <u>Approximately</u> 2.45pm Wednesday 6th March at the bus bay outside the school. <u>Please do not ring</u> the school switch. They <u>cannot</u> give you a more accurate time.

EXPECTED CONDUCT: **Crestwood High School's Code of Behaviour** will apply and exemplary behaviour is expected at all times. Should the matter arise, parents will be contacted by telephone on matters of discipline and may be asked to take their son/daughter home. No student may leave The Tops Conference Centre unless part of an approved organised group, which is accompanied by a member of the Crestwood HS Staff. All instructions given by teachers, <u>camp staff</u> and coach drivers must be followed immediately. Students are expected to be Safe, Respectful Learners at all times.

<u>Luggage</u>: Each student may only take one bag to be stored in the luggage compartment of the coach. Students will not be able to access this bag once it is loaded. A small backpack would be useful to carry their water bottle (issued to all students at camp) and wet weather gear.

No food or drink is to be consumed whilst on the coach. Mobile phones, cameras or other electronic devices are not permitted as per the school's policy. Furthermore, do not bring any valuable items. We have had losses in the past and we do not encourage these items to be taken.

Spending money: Since all of the requirements are provided on the camp, spending money is not needed.

What to take in your luggage: In the event of wet weather please pack plenty of changes of clothes as most activities will continue in the rain. Waterproof bags are essential to take wet clothes home.

There are *no water activities* at this camp.

Do not bring good clothes, make-up, or expensive jewellery. Singlets, sleeveless tops or midriff garments are not to be worn to any activities. There is a safety concern (harness) for many of the activities your child will be involved in.

Medication: Place medication in a labelled (Name of student and medication, dosage and time) zip lock bag and give to the Year Adviser at the bus bay on Monday morning.
